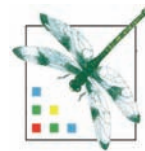

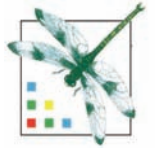

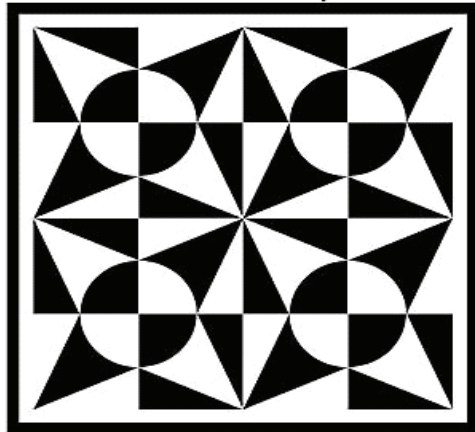
### Santa Rosa County Middle School Art Students Exhibit March 15 – March 31.
