Introductory Beadweaving- Join Jewelry artist **Valorie Clifton** and make a wonderful, Victorian style bracelet on Saturdays February 12 and Feb. 26. In this month's beginner's class we will learn the Cross-Weave stitch and some handy tips and tricks to successful beadweaving. We will cover some basic bead knowledge, compare bead types and explore helpful beading supplies. Some color and clasp variations will be provided for this design. -You are welcome to bring a snack or a lunch since this class will continue into the afternoon. Materials will be furnished .

Tuition per session: Foundation Members \$25 Non-members \$20.

Introduction to Panoramic Photography - Taught by Gallery Artist **Frank Harwood**.

Participants will learn fundamentals of panoramic photography, including subject selection, composition techniques, and camera settings. Participants will take photos in the field, return to the classroom and transform their photos into panorama images using Adobe Photoshop Elements. Also covered will be suggestions for printing and mounting.

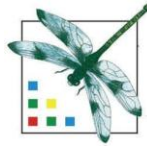
